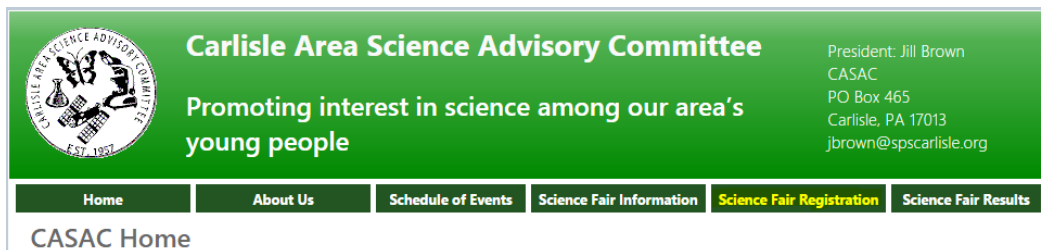


CASAC Science Fair Registration – NOW ONLINE through December 14th

IMPORTANT

1. All students should take their projects to Carlisle High School Swartz building on Friday, January 22, 2016 between 4:30 and 5:45 pm. There can be NO exceptions such as early setup or late check-in due to tight set-up and judging schedules.
2. The science fair will be open to the public Saturday, January 23, 2016 from 1:00 pm until 6:00 pm and again on Sunday, January 24, 2016 from 1:00 pm until 3:00 pm.
3. Project pick-up will be on Sunday, January 24, 2016 from 3:00 – 4:30 pm. If a child's project cannot be picked-up during this time period, please arrange for another person to do so for you.
4. Tear down of the science fair facility will begin on Sunday, January 24, 2016 at 3:30 pm and conclude by 5:00 pm. Projects not removed by 5:00 pm on Sunday, January 24, 2016 will be discarded. Since other students and families want to see your student's work, projects may NOT be removed before 3:00 pm on Sunday, January 24, 2016.

4. Notify your teacher (if you haven't already) that you have submitted your entry and that he or she will need to approve the project and the entry before 12/21/2018
5. If you want to verify your entry is approved, go back to the website and click on the menu for "Science Fair Registration", and click the link to check the status of your entry

8. Group Projects should only be entered ONCE on the website – select “Yes” for Group Project, and enter the names of all students in the group (up to 3 students)

10. Any photographs displayed on your board should NOT show faces
