

MARLIN E. BLOSSER MEMORIAL GRANT

DESCRIPTION

The Marlin E. Blosser Memorial Grant is offered to TWO Carlisle High School seniors annually. The amount of each grant will be approximately \$3,000.00 per school year for the duration of the post secondary program, not to exceed two years or \$6,000.00. The criteria for each selection will be based on <u>financial</u> need and plans to pursue additional education at a vocational school or industrial arts school, or similar vocational training beyond high school.

Carlisle seniors will receive notice of the Marlin E. Blosser Memorial Grant. The Carlisle High School Scholarship Committee whose membership is made up of a counselor and five faculty members will identify FOUR students to be presented to a selection committee whose membership is made up of the Career & Technology Director, a Carlisle High School administrator, Carlisle High School Career & Technology teacher and a member of the General Advisory Committee. TWO recipients will be chosen for the Blosser Memorial Grant. ONE grant will be awarded to a senior who is currently enrolled in an approved Carlisle High School Career & Technical Education Program.

APPLICATION

Applications for the scholarship will be available in the McGowan Counseling Center. Completed applications should be returned promptly to the Counseling Center.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Any senior who has attended Carlisle High School for at least one year is eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- 2. The student must be accepted by a post-secondary vocational/technical and or/industrial arts school.
- 3. Recipients must enroll in an appropriate qualifying school.
- 4. Students must attach the most recent family's W-2 form with the application.
- 5. Disbursement of the Grant will be administered by the Trustee and forwarded directly to the institution.
- 6. The grant recipient, on a regular basis, must submit transcripts of post-secondary grades to the trustee. Passing grades must be maintained.
