

## Re-Engagement Education Program

Central PA Family Support Services established a Re-Engagement Education Program to provide students and their families with convenient access to information and placement services leading to reenrollment in their education.

The Re-Engagement Education Program is open to children and adults between the ages of 6-21, who have disconnected from school (such as truancy or drop out). Trained, knowledgeable staff can help the disconnected student by:

- Evaluating their academic needs and goals
- Provide GED Pre-Tests, co-ordinate GED Classes and GED Testing
- Directing the youth to the right academic program
- Providing access to necessary support services
- Offering guidance and support to increase the student's academic success
- Seeking Job Placement
- Providing Pro-Social Activities and Skills

Our Re-Engagement Program Staff will work with the school and family to ensure that students dealing with behavioral health issues will have access to treatment programs and supports that will encourage a successful return to school.

Our Re-Engagement Education Program is also available for students that are enrolled in Cyber-School, from Elementary to High School ages. Students have the opportunity to work with our trained staff to assist them with all of their schoolwork.

## Our staff is able to:

- Maintain an effective link between the home, cyber-school and home school district.
- Supervise and monitor the progress of the student.
- Provide support services through Central PA Family Support Services.

Our Re-Engagement Education Program Staff will work with all systems that are involved with the student's educational development to help promote academic success.
